- The Freedom Tunnel.. 6 Palestinian detainees gained their freedom from the Israeli «Gilboa» prison by digging an underground tunnel. They are Mahmoud Al-Ardah, Yaqoub Qadri, Muhammad Al-Ardah, Zakaria Al-Zubaidi, Ayham Nayef Kamamaji and Munadil Nfea'at.
- The occupation forces announce the arrest of 4 detainees who gained their freedom from Gilboa prison, they are Mahmoud Al-Ardah, Yagoub Qadri, Muhammad Al-Ardah and Zakaria Al-Zubaidi, in the city of Nazareth in the occupied territories.
- After the success of the Freedom Tunnel incident, the repression units of the occupation prisons administration carried out a fierce attack using tear gas on Palestinian detainees in several Israeli prisons, and severe tension prevailed in all prisons until this moment.





- The movement of prisoners inside prisons and detention centers announces a general mobilization and rebellion against all prison administration laws if the repressive and punitive measures taken against them continue.
- The detainees set fire to several prisons in protest against the fierce crackdown they are being subjected to.
- Detainee Malek Hamed from Silwad pours hot water on a jailer in Gilboa prison in response to the repression and abuse of prisoners.
- The International Committee of the Red Cross informs the families of the detainees of canceling visits to their children in prisons, until the end of September, due to the recent incidents in prisons.
- Detainees Information Office: Work is underway inside the prisons of the Israeli occupation to adopt a «bold strategy» that will be unified in all prisons, in response to the repression and abuse of detainees.
- Mass marches in all Palestinian governorates in support of the detainees in the face of the repression and attacks they are subjected to from the occupation prisons administration.
- A new deterioration in the health condition of the detainee, Kayed Al-Fosfous, who is on hunger strike, in refusal to be administratively detained, knowing that he was transferred to a hospital inside the occupied territories.



- #Save_Isra_Jaabis A Palestinian, Arab and international campaign to demand the release of the wounded detainee, Israa Jaabis, so that she can receive the necessary treatment and end the medical negligence she suffers from inside the prisons of the Israeli occupation.
- The Israeli occupation authorities transferred the striking detainee Miqdad Al-Qawasmi to the Israeli «Kaplan» hospital, after his health condition deteriorated.



- Detainee Khaled Daraghmeh loses sight completely in one eye, and gradually begins to lose sight in the other eye as a result of the policy of medical negligence inside the prison and the delay in providing the necessary treatment to save his sight.
- The occupation forces transfer the Jerusalemite detainee Anan Najeeb to solitary confinement in Beersheba prison.
